A limited statutory examination consists primarily of inquiries of personnel and analytical procedures as well as detailed tests of documents of the unit as considered necessary in the circumstances. However, the testing of operational processes and the internal control system, as well as inquiries and further testing procedures to detect fraud or other legal violations, are not within the scope of this examination.

Based on our limited statutory examination, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the financial statements do not comply with Swiss law and the association's articles of incorporation.

### **NOTES**

#### **General information**

The Association is domiciled in Zug and registered in the commercial registry in Zug. The object of the Association is to represent and protect the interests and rights of the Zug based community of companies active in the supply chain of commodities. The association has no employees. All administrative work is done by IFZ.

These financial statements were prepared according to the provisions of the Swiss Law on Accounting and Financial Reporting (32nd title of the Swiss Code of Obligations).

#### **General accounting principles**

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention.

Assets and liabilities are stated at face value unless mentioned otherwise.

Assets and liabilities - denominated in foreign currency are converted into Swiss Francs using the year-end exchange rates, the profit and loss statement by the average for the year rates except major transactions which are converted using the spot rate as of the transaction date.

#### **Principles for the determination of the result**

Interest is accounted for based on the accrual method. Administrative expenses are charged against the profit and loss statement in the year to which they relate to.

#### **Significant events after the balance sheet date**

There are no significant events after the balance sheet date which could impact the book value of the assets or liabilities which should be disclosed here.
