ZCA offers a workshop to support commodity trading companies in their continuing effort in implementing human rights due diligence (HRDD).

This in-depth workshop aims to show participants how risks along the value chain can be identified and prioritized in the context of human rights due diligence and how a company can adequately address the identified risks. The focus is therefore on the development of a risk management system. In addition to general HRDD topics, the workshop provides an overview of the latest legislative developments in Switzerland (incl. the counterproposal of the Responsible Business Initiative (RBI) and its implementing ordinance) and abroad. The event is tailored to the commodity trading industry and focuses on practical exercises and peer exchange.
