Terms of Use and Privacy Policy

General Information

Welcome to the website of the Zug Commodity Association (ZCA).

The terms of use and data protection are intended to provide information on the type, scope and purpose of the collection and use of person data by the ZCA and on the use of the website in accordance with the Federal Data Protection Act (FADP).

If you access, read or use the website www.zugcommodity.ch, you accept the following terms of use and data protection.

The ZCA takes your data protection very seriously and treats your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory provisions.

Handling of personal data

The ZCA regulates the collection, storage, processing and forwarding of personal data of users below. All information that is used to identify your person is considered personal data. The personal data such as your name, your e-mail/postal/IP address, date of birth, gender, language, telephone number, occupation, interests, or information about the use of our services (here referred to as "data") can be traced back to you.

We endeavor to store your data through technical and organizational measures in such a way that they are

not accessible to third parties. Please note that the Internet is a publicly accessible system. Data entered into the system can be lost, end up in the wrong addressee or in the hands of unauthorized people. For this reason, all personal information and data is provided voluntarily and at your own risk.

If you use the services of third parties via the website, their terms of use and data protection apply exclusively.

Registration for Membership

The data provided when registering for an ZCA membership will be used to provide regular information about news and events.

Registration for ZCA events

The data of participants will be made available to the other participants of the same event (only last name, first name and company). Participants are prohibited from using the information for advertising purposes. However, networking and contacting one another is desired.

The ZCA saves the date and uses it to regularly inform the participants about news and events. The participant list can also be passed on to partners in order to be used by them for the same purposes.

Sign up for Newsletter

When registering for subscription such as the newsletter, a valid email address is required. This can be supplemented by the ZCA with researched personal data and included in the database of the ZCA and the founding partner in order to provide regular information

about news and events. You can unsubscribe from the newsletter mentioned at any time.

General contact

If you contact the ZCA using the contact options offered, your details will be saved to answer the request. This data will not be passed on to third parties without your consent.

Access data

The ZCA collects data about access to the website and saves this as "server log files".

The data collected is only used for statistical evaluations and to improve the website. However, the website operator reserves the right to subsequently check the server log files if there are concrete indications of illegal use.

Cookies

The website may use cookies. Cookies are small data packages that are stored on your computer and managed by your browser. Cookies enable, for example, faster navigation on website and personalized access. You can delete cookies in the browser at any time.

We use the "Real Cookie Banner" consent tool to manage the cookies and similar technologies used (tracking pixels, web beacons, etc.) and the relevant consents. Details on how "Real Cookie Banner" works can be found [here](#).

There is no guarantee that you will be able to access all functions of this website without restrictions if you make the appropriate settings.

Use of social media plugins

When clicking on such plugins, personal data such as the IP address can be collected and used by the respective provider. We refer to the usage and data protection regulations of the individual social media providers.
